Research stays of doctoral students from abroad at Bergische Universität Wuppertal Call for tender

For the promotion of internalisation and network building, IPIW supports the research stays of international doctoral candidates of Humanities- and Cultural Studies (Faculty 1) as well as Human- and Social Sciences (Faculty 2) at Bergische Universität Wuppertal.

Eligibility criteria

The funding can be profited by all the disciplines of Humanities- and Cultural Studies (Faculty 1) as well as Human- and Social Sciences (Faculty 2). All the doctoral candidates who have so far not completed their Ph.D with the disputation, are eligible.

Funding includes:

- A travel lump sum as per DAAD standards
- An accommodation lump sum as per DAAD standards, for the time period of one to three months. The grant offers the fixed allowance (of 250.- € / Woche) and not the actual costs. The trip has to be made within the year 2017. The lump sum for the accommodation can only be granted for the year of 2017.

Criteria for selection

- Research project of the doctoral candidates
- Necessity of the research stay for the progress of Ph.D
- Academic resume of the doctoral candidate

- Abstract containing the research topic
- Reasoning the requirement of the research stay
- Academic CV (optional: list of publications)
- The letter of support by the supervisor of the international university
- Letter of acceptance from one of the professors at Bergische Universität Wuppertal (can be given later)
- Work and time schedule
